### **Newsletter No.2 (2010/11)**

The Executive Committee (EC) would like to wish all of you a smooth & fruitful Year of the Rabbit. We would like to present here a brief report on what the EC has done and to announce some of the forthcoming events.

#### **A. Reports**

##### **1. Membership**

This year we have a total of 348 member schools registered, covering all the subsidized secondary schools in Hong Kong.

##### **2. Annual General Meeting (2010/11)**

The AGM (2010/11) was held on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2010 with an attendance of 171 member school principals. After the AGM, we were pleased to have Mr. Eddie NG Hak-kim, JP, Chairman of Hong Kong Examinations & Assessment Authority to share with us his views on “考評新趨勢與人才培育”.

##### **3. Co-opted EC members**

Mr. Alex CHU Kai-wing of CCC Heep Woh College, Mr. TSO Tat-ming of YCH Lim Por Yen Secondary School and Ms. LAU Sau-yin of QES Old Students' Association Secondary School have been invited as co-opted members.

##### **4. Survey on Educational Issues**

In order to solicit the views of member schools on class structure, the EC conducted a survey by questionnaire in September 2010. Another survey on School Repairs and Maintenance was conducted by questionnaire in January 2011. Members can refer to the Council webpage for the results and reports of the two surveys.

##### **5. Meetings with EDB and other Educational Bodies**

(a) 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2010: Meeting with Ms. Mabel CHAN, Deputy Secretary (Ed)2. EC members expressed the concerns on the MOI Focus Inspection and issues on S1 allocation in order to maintain sustainable development of secondary schools after the Enhanced Measures on Optimization of Class Structure Scheme.

(b) 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2010: Meeting with Mrs. Michelle WONG, Deputy Secretary (Ed)4. The meeting was mainly on the discussions of Integrated Education and the problems arisen due to the recent changes in the administration of school major repairs.

- (c) 26<sup>th</sup> January 2011: Meeting with Mrs. Cherry TSE LING Kit-ching, PSED on recent educational issues. The following issues were discussed: (1) Review of curriculum development; (2) How to ensure successful implementation of 334; (3) Time schedule for review of staff establishment; and (4) Overall review of government resources for school administration to cater for changes since year 2000.
- (d) 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2011: Meeting with Ms. Mabel CHAN, Deputy Secretary (Ed)2. The meeting was mainly on problems related to school repairs & maintenance and issues related to SSPA.
